Step-by-Step

MAKING A MINI HERB GARDEN DEMO

- Step 1: Choose & prepare containers (ensure drainage holes)
- Step 2: Fill pots with soil (leave about 1 inch from the top)
- Step 3: Planting your herbs (depth, spacing, care tips)
- Step 4: Watering & placement (first watering, where to place for best growth)
- Step 5: Ongoing care (watering schedule, pruning tips, fertilizing every few weeks)



Beginner friendly plants



BASIL

Fast-growing, great for cooking, loves warmth and sunlight



MINT

Easy to grow, thrives indoors, good for teas and freshening drinks



PARSLEY

Hardy, versatile in cooking, slow-growing but rewarding



THYME

A hardy, drought-tolerant herb with a mild, earthy flavor

Common Problems

- Leggy plants?
- Yellowing leaves?
- Slow growth?

Solution

- Not enough light – move to a sunnier spot or use grow lights
- Overwatering – let soil dry slightly between watering
- Lack of nutrients – use diluted organic fertilizer
